

BOULDER CREEK COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

Effective May 12th, 2020

GENERAL


In the effort to flatten the curve and reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19 we strongly encourage all Albertans to protect themselves and others by practicing these common steps:

- Practice physical distancing at all times, minimum of 2 meters between each other.
- Wash your hands regularly with warm water and soap for at least 20 seconds.
- Cover your cough with a tissue or your elbow.
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands.
- Be aware of COVID-19 symptoms; cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose or sore throat. If these symptoms exist, please self-isolate and contact 811.


YOUR DAY AT BOULDER CREEK

In an effort to make the day as enjoyable and safe as possible, the Boulder Creek team has instituted a number of industry approved standards to mitigate the risk of transmission of COVID-19 and ensure the health and safety of our golfers, staff and homeowners around the course.

1. Arrive at the golf course no more than 30 minutes prior to the start of your pre-booked tee time.
2. All golfers may enter the Pro Shop and check in when they arrive. All door handles are sanitized frequently.
3. Golfers may share a power cart if they are part of the same co-hort. Once ready, the golfers will head to the designated holding area on their power cart until the 1st tee is cleared of the group in front.

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4. Pull carts will be available. All power and pull carts will be washed and disinfected after each use.
5. Once the #1 Tee has cleared the group in front, the following group will be allowed to proceed to the tee for further on course instructions from another Boulder Team member.
6. Scorecards and pencils will be made available but only through request at the #1 Tee.
7. All on course washrooms are disinfected hourly
8. All rakes, ball washers and benches will be removed from the golf course. Please proceed as you want in the bunker (preferred lie, remove from bunker). If you do play from the bunker, please smooth footprints as best as you can for the next golfer.
9. All flagsticks must remain in the cup and please do not touch the flagstick at any time.
10. Maintain physical distancing at all times on the golf course. At the end of the round, air high 5's, air fist bumps or a smile are strongly encouraged.
11. Upon completion of play, you will be permitted to drop clubs off at car and then follow the signage and staff directions as to where to drop off the power cart/pull cart at the designated area.
12. Smile, remember only the good shots and have a great day!

By simply following these industry approved protocols we can ensure the health and safety of our golfers and staff and help to flatten the curve.

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
